**Approximate preparation time needed:** Our Storyteller spent uncounted prep time. We'll spend about an hour on the actual date of the performance.

**Additionally, you might want to describe further your program and how it is implemented:** At noon, participants will begin a workshop with the Storytailor, who has several short stories ready to tell. She will teach the participants, who can be any age, young or old (parents and grandparents are welcome to participate, too!) how to be a storyteller and will give them each a role in at least one of the stories. After becoming familiar with the stories and learning the lines and lyrics in Spanish and in English, the group will join in as the Storytailor leads this performance of Cuentos y Canciones at 4pm to a larger audience of friends, family and the library public. Celebration will follow with cupcakes and a gift of a bilingual book to each child.
